**NAP5: Accidental Awareness during General Anaesthesia – Baseline Survey 2011**

We are enclosing a baseline survey to inform further development of the NAP5 Project. This will help us know the current state of the service with respect to the likely incidence and protocols in place for handling accidental awareness.
